Alice Virginia Maddox White, 87, of 4171 Roaring Run Road, Goode, VA, died Tuesday, January 29, 2019 at Lynchburg General Hospital, VA. She was the wife of the late Arthur Remington White, Jr., in a marriage that spanned 55 years.

She was born November 24, 1931 in Richmond, VA, a daughter of the late Paul Maddox and Hilda Etta Cornell Maddox. She was a member of Providence United Methodist Church, Charlotte, NC, and a retired nurse. Alice was proud to be one of the founding members of The Haiti Mission and a Master of Foxhounds of the Meckinburg Hunt.
