Arthur Patrick Papa Art Farries, 88, of 55 Beale Rd., Lynch Station, died Sunday, June 6, 2010 at his home. He was the husband of Ruth Hughes Cox Farries. He was born November 23, 1921 in Campbell County, the son of the late Robert Thomas Farries and the late Myrtle Burnette Farries. He was the former owner/operator of Colonial Furniture in Lynchburg, a member of Lynch Station Baptist Church, a deacon in the church and sang with the Lynch Station Men's Vocal group. Arthur was a World War II veteran serving with the U.S. Army Air Corps. in the South Pacific.
