Aubrey Clinton "A.C." Orrell, Jr., 71, of Hurt died Friday, May 15, 2020. He was the husband of the late Linda Lambert Orrell.

He was born August 27, 1948 in Lynchburg, a son of the late Aubrey Clinton Orrell, Sr. and Beulah Payne Orrell.
