



## Binford Burks Nash, Sr.

August 14, 1933 - November 14, 2013

Binford Burks Nash, Sr., 80, of 1094 Pigeon Run Road, Gladys died unexpectedly on Thursday, November 14, 2013. He was the beloved husband of Bessie Brown Nash for over sixty years.

He was born August 14, 1933 in Appomattox County, a son of the late Hunter S. Nash and Willie Burks Nash. He was a member of Kedron Baptist Church where he served as a deacon and trustee. Binnie was the former owner of Nash Trucking Inc., a charter member of the Gladys Volunteer Fire Department and Gladys Ruritan Club, held membership in Mackey Lodge #69 A.F. and A.M. for over 50 years. He was the recipient in 2012 of the Golden Achievement Award for over 50 years in the trucking business given by the American Truck Historical Society and honorably served his country in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a son, Binford Burks Nash, Jr. "Little Binnie" and his wife Susan of Gladys; a daughter, Deborah Nash Burman and her husband Don of Eagle Point, Oregon; two brothers, Buford H. Nash and wife Janet of Gladys and Paul T. Nash and wife Peggy of Ohio; five grandchildren, Jennifer N. Becker (Matthew), Keri B. Castro (Daniel), Jessica L. Nash, Collin N. Burman (Nicole), and Jillian E. Nash; two great grandchildren, Lily Becker and Presley Burman.

He was preceded in death by a brother, David S. Nash.

A funeral service will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Sunday, November 17, 2013 at Kedron Baptist Church, Gladys by the Rev. Brian Reynolds with interment to follow in the church cemetery. Military honors by the U.S. Navy Funeral Honor Guard.

The family will receive friends following the service in the church fellowship hall and other times at the residence.
