Brian Elwood Krantz, 54, of Gladys died Friday, September 4, 2020.

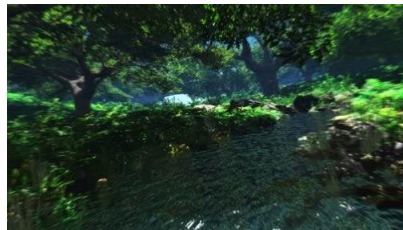
