



Carroll Brumfield

May 23, 1931 - January 22, 2010

Carroll Oscar Brumfield, 78, of Forest, died Friday, January 22, 2010 at Lynchburg General Hospital. He was the husband of Billie June Belcher Brumfield for over fifty-four years. He was born May 23, 1931 in Altavista, a son of the late Oscar Brumfield and Ethel Mae Dalton Brumfield. He was a 1949 graduate of Altavista High School, attended Lynchburg College, and received bank management degrees from UVA and LSU. Mr. Brumfield formerly served as the manager of Central Fidelity Bank in Altavista, from which he later retired as a Senior Vice-President and Branch Administrator. He was a member of Hyland Heights Baptist Church and formerly served as a Deacon with Central Baptist Church in Altavista. He served three terms on the Altavista Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, two terms on the Altavista Town Council, the Plymale Foundation Committee, and the Altavista Area YMCA Board of Directors, where he was a founding member. Additionally, Carroll found time to coach tennis, baseball, and basketball at Altavista High School and the Altavista Area YMCA. In addition to his wife, he is survived by one daughter, Robin B. Moreland and her husband David of Rustburg; one son, Christopher C. Brumfield and his wife Micki of Altavista; one sister, Marguerite B. Finch of Altavista; five grandchildren, Jeremy Moreland, Jennifer Moreland, Jordan Moreland, Jillian Moreland, and Andra Brumfield; and one great-grandson, Evan Bethel. A funeral service will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, January 26, 2010 at the Finch & Finch Chapel by the Rev. Carl Weiser with burial to follow in Green Hill Cemetery.
