



Catherine McDaniel McPeters

October 17, 1933 - July 28, 2025

Catherine Lee McDaniel McPeters, 91, of Altavista, peacefully went home to be with the Lord on Monday, July 28, 2025, at her residence. She was the beloved wife of the late Rondell Charles McPeters.

Born on October 17, 1933, in Pittsylvania County, she was the daughter of the late William Ward McDaniel and Mildred Lee McDaniel Overstreet. Catherine was a life-long member of Lambs Community Church and retired from Central Virginia Training Center, where she worked as a nurse in their hospital.
