Clair Riddle Hall, 95, of Chatham, passed away on Monday, June 3, 2013 at Chatham Health and Rehabilitation Center. She was the wife of the late Wilbert Clayton Hall.

She was born August 3, 1917 in Pittsylvania County, a daughter of the late Benjamin Riddle and Mintie Craddock Riddle. Clair was a member of Oak Grove Christian Church, a member of the ladies church auxillary, choir and the Rawley Martin Chapter of United Daughters of the Confederacy. She was a retired secretary to the Superintendent of the Pittsylvania County School Board and enjoyed rug hooking and spent many happy hours making gifts for her family and friends.

She is survived by a son, David C. Hall and his wife Janna of Hurt; a daughter, Martha H. Taylor of Renan; and two brothers, Guy Riddle and his wife Iris and Benjamin Riddle all of Chatham.
