



## Coleman Alvis Doss, Jr.

February 25, 1943 - April 5, 2015

Coleman Alvis (C.A.) Doss, Jr., of 8113 Virginia Byway, Bedford died Sunday, April 5, 2015 at Lynchburg General Hospital after a long battle with illness.

He was born February 25, 1943 in Dunnett, MD, the son of the late Coleman Alvis Doss, Sr. and Sibyl Dudley Doss. He was a member of Hurt United Methodist Church, Forest Lodge #245 AF and AM, Lynchburg South Moose Lodge #1727, and the NRA.
