Curtis Elmo "Sam" Johnson, 88, of Hurt entered into his eternal Home on Saturday, February 13, 2021. He was the husband of Madeline Hamlett Johnson for 60 years.

He was born November 26, 1932 in Pittsylvania County, a son of the late Clarence and Sallie Robertson Johnson. He retired from BGF, but decided retirement was not for him, he went back to work at Abbott, retiring at age 85.

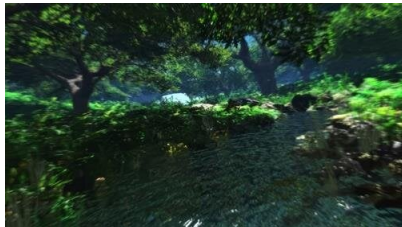
