Donald Henry Tucker, 87, of Altavista died Tuesday, October 1, 2019 at Runk and Pratt Liberty Ridge Assisted Living. He was the husband of the late Virginia Sitton Tucker for sixty-six years.

He was born June 19, 1932 in Campbell County, a son of the late Walter Paris Tucker and Emma Mae Hackworth. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Altavista, a retired Vice President of The Lane Company, and a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict.

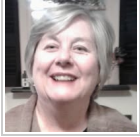
