Elizabeth Lois Barbour McCrickard, 84, of Rustburg, died Thursday, February 16, 2017 at her home. She was the wife of Alvin Thomas McCrickard for sixty-four years.

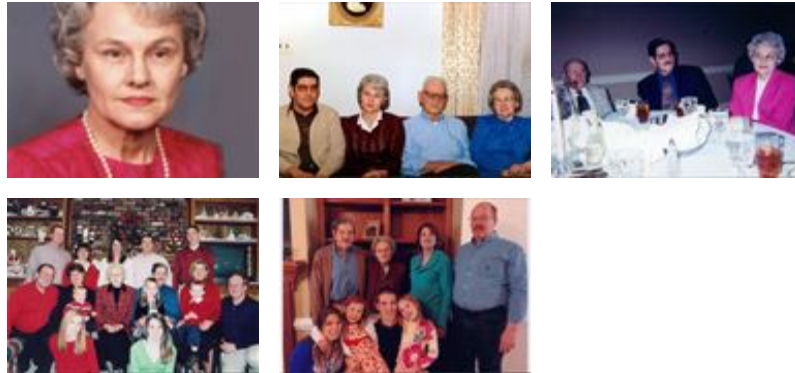
