He was the husband of the late Doris Hogan Pugh. He was born August 26, 1922 in Campbell County, a son of the late Nathan Pugh and Rosa Fariss Pugh. He was a retired supervisor with The Lane Company, a member of Clement Memorial Wesleyan Church, VFW Post 4165, and American Legion Post 16. Mr. Pugh was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, where he served with the 10th Armored Division in the 95th Infantry under General Patton. During the war he fought in the Battle of Normandy during the D-Day invasion and the Battle of the Bulge in Central Europe. During his tour of duty he received the Purple Heart. He is survived by a son, Les Pugh and his wife Cindy of Altavista; a daughter, Patricia Mueller and her husband David of Gladys; a granddaughter, Melissa Martin of Lynchburg; and a grandson, Justin Pugh of Charlotte, North Carolina. He was preceded in death by two sisters, Edith P. Crouch and Gladys P. Fowler; and five brothers, Jim, Arthur, Cylawyer, Nat, and Harvey Pugh. A funeral service will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Friday, December 4, 2009 in the Finch & Finch Chapel, Altavista by the Rev. David Bayse and the Rev. Bobby Brumfield with burial to follow in Altavista Memorial Park with military honors by VFW Post 4165.
