Fred Kabler Tucker, Jr., 80, passed away peacefully on August 13, 2024 in Lynchburg, VA.

Fred was raised in Lynch Station, VA, by the late Fred K Tucker, Sr, and Vera Tucker (Eggers) and was a graduate of Altavista High School. He was the first in his family to graduate from University with a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Virginia in Aerospace Engineering. Fred was an inducted member in the honorary prestigious engineering Fraternity, Theta Tau. His successful career path took him first to Greensburg, PA where he was part of a team for an American company, Elliott Abara Energy. A world leader in developing diesel turbine engine technology which expanded internationally as a subsidiary of United Technologies. Fred traveled extensively with this expansion to develop and manufacture industrial products. Fred received an MBA from Penn State University and served as Vice-President of Jenn-Air Products Company in Indianapolis, IN. Future promotions within the Maytag company took Fred to Penn State, PA as well as North and South Carolina. Fred retired in 2004 and returned to Lynch Station, VA to care for his aging mother.

Fred's favorite past time and hobbies included working on and collecting American muscle cars, a lifelong hunter, an avid reader, listening to rock & roll music and especially enjoyed the company of his dogs. Fred and his son,

Mike, enjoyed traveling internationally to western Canada to visit his daughter, Marnie and two grandsons every summer.

Fred is preceded in death by his sister, Pat Tucker, and his brother, Dan Tucker.
