



## Irvine Randolph Tucker

September 21, 1926 - December 28, 2016

Irvine Randolph Tucker, 90, of Lexington, South Carolina, formerly of Greensboro, North Carolina, died Wednesday, December 28, 2016 at his home. He was the husband of Cornelia Hendricks Tucker for seventy-two years.

He was born September 21, 1926 in Pittsylvania County, Virginia a son of the late Claude Tucker and Doris Hodnett Tucker. Mr. Tucker started his career at the Lane Furniture Company in Altavista, Virginia and continued his career as an Industrial Engineer and Plant Manager at H K Porter Company in Danville, Virginia; Proctor Silex in Mount Airy, North Carolina; and Clyde Pearson Furniture Company in High Point, North Carolina. After leaving the corporate industry he owned and operated Fields Furniture Store in Greensboro. Upon retirement, he resided in Banner Elk, North Carolina and Foley, Alabama near his two daughters. Recently he relocated to Lexington, South Carolina. He was a U.S. Army veteran serving during World War II.
