



## Julian "Butch" James Anderson III

August 10, 1942 - December 29, 2015

Julian James Anderson, III, 73, of Rustburg died Tuesday, December 29, 2015 at Lynchburg General Hospital.

He was born August 10, 1942, in Lynchburg, a son of the late Julian James Anderson, Jr, and Jeannette Jones Anderson. The oldest of six children, he is survived by three brothers, Robert Anderson (June) of Roanoke, Richard Anderson of Rustburg, and Douglas Anderson (Dianne) of Dublin; two sisters, Pamela Jackson of Lynchburg and Karen Hicks (Matthew) of Burke; a number of nieces, nephews, and cousins; and a longtime friend, Myrtle Hall, and her husband, Jim. Butch was preceded in death by an uncle, Edgar Poe Anderson; the two grew up together as brothers.

Butch lived in Rustburg all his life, first on the family farm off Rocky Road, and then off Gough Road since the early 1980s. After graduating from Rustburg High School and Phillips Business College, he worked as a bookkeeper for Dinner Bell Meat Products for over forty years. He was a lifelong member of Rustburg United Methodist Church where he served in various lay roles. Limited by kidney disease his entire life, Butch was unable to enjoy many passions most take for granted; however, he was an avid NASCAR fan dating back to the Petty-Pearson era of the 1960s and attended his last race just months ago at Bristol. Outside of work and church activities, "Uncle Butch" enjoyed being outdoors around the house, especially on his lawn mower.

A memorial service will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, January 2, 2016 at Rustburg United Methodist Church by the Rev. Sung W. Yoo. A private family burial will be at a later date.

His siblings wish to extend special thanks to Mr. and Mrs. Doug Tyler for their loving friendship to Butch over the years. They would also like to thank his extended family, neighbors, church members, Mr. G.D. Gilliam and the health care professionals at Duke University Hospital and Lynchburg General Hospital.
