



## June Talley Hankla

June 20, 1936 - January 29, 2013

June Talley Hankla, 76, of Rustburg passed away peacefully at her home with her family by her side on Tuesday, January 29, 2013. She was the beloved wife of the late William "Buddy" Alfred Hankla for forty-two years.

She was born June 20, 1936 in Campbell County, a daughter of the late William Isaac Talley and Isabell Tanner Talley. She was a life-long member of Mount Zion United Methodist Church in Rustburg, where she was the church organist since 1964. She also served as the Treasurer, Secretary, Sunday School Teacher and Choir Director.
