Lee Arthur Chaffin, 92, of Hurt and formerly of Annandale, died Sunday, June 5, 2016 at Lynchburg General Hospital.

He was born October 30, 1923 in Ithaca, Michigan, a son of the late Wesley Chaffin and Helen Reeb Chaffin. Lee retired from the Civil Defense Department in the Department of Defense as a national transportation director, and proudly served his country as a veteran of the U.S. Army during WWII.

He is survived by a son, James Lee Chaffin of Hurt; two daughters, Lyndia "Lindy" Stewart and her husband Jeffrey of Hurt and Linda Lee DeMurio and her husband Bruce of Fulton, MO; thirteen grandchildren; thirteen great grandchildren and two great-great grandchildren; and a brother, Robert Chaffin.

He was preceded in death by two brothers.

In keeping with Mr. Chaffin's wishes, he will be cremated and the family will have a private gathering at a later date.
