

Lyle Snead Boley Jr.

October 14, 1942 - December 19, 2024

Lyle S. "Butch" Boley, Jr. of Rustburg died Thursday, December 19, 2024 after a brief illness.

Butch was born in Campbell County on October 14, 1942. He was the oldest son of the late Lyle Snead Boley and Elsie Hensley Boley. He was predeceased by his son, Lyle Snead Boley III and grandson, Brett Boley.

He is survived by his wife, Emmie Glenn Boley; two daughters, Stella Boley of Lynchburg and Carla O'Brien of Pamplin; one son, Curtis "Bo" Boley and his wife, Connie of Gretna; five sisters, Louise Hall and her husband, Bill of Orange Park, Florida, Bernice Myers of Altavista, Shelia Hudson and her husband, Victor of Altavista, Sandra Hall and her husband, Barry of Altavista and Roberta Hall and her husband, Larry of Grandy, North Carolina; one brother, Robert "Buzz" Boley and his wife, Sherry of Bedford; six grandchildren, Colby Burnam (Katherine), Collins O'Brien (Nina), Caitlyn Matthews (Travis), Christopher Boley (Leah), Casey Boley and Nicholas Boley; and a number of great grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

In his early career, Butch worked as a local drywall contractor and completed his public work with the Miami Veterans Affairs Healthcare System in Miami, Florida and was a veteran of the United States Air Force. Butch received his ministerial credentials in 2009 and acted as an assistant to the Pastor at First

Assembly of God in Lynchburg, Virginia before planting Trinity Lighthouse Community Church in Hurt, Virginia in 2014. During that time, Butch strived to present the Gospel effectively to those who crossed his path. Butch loved his family, fishing, hunting and spending time with his family and friends.

A funeral service will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Monday, December 23, 2024 at Trinity Lighthouse Community Church, 209 Main Street, Hurt, Virginia 24563 by his son, Curtis "Bo" Boley and brother, Robert "Buzz" Boley with interment to follow in Mount Hermon Church Cemetery with military honors by American Legion Altavista Memorial Post 36 and Gretna Post 232.

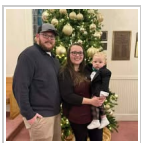
