Margaret Ferguson Fauver, 69, of 2216 Beech Ave., Altavista died Thursday, February 26, 2015 at home. She was the wife of Joseph Timothy Fauver.

She was born May 1, 1945 in Lynchburg, a daughter of the late Herbert Guy Ferguson and Irene Richardson Ferguson Davis. She was a member of Altavista Presbyterian Church and a retired co-owner and manager of McDonald's Corporation.
