Marie Ogle Blackstock, 92, of Altavista died Wednesday, February 4, 2015 at Autumn Care of Altavista. She was the wife of the late Cabell Roy Blackstock.

She was born August 15, 1922 in Wythe County, VA a daughter of the late Joseph Preston Ogle and Lula Dalton Ogle. She was a member of Straightstone Baptist Church and a homemaker. Marie grew up in Austinville, VA, attended Radford and James Madison Colleges; was the former owner of the Fabric Shop on Broad Street in Altavista, a part-time teacher, active volunteer at the Altavista YMCA and Lynchburg General Hospital, and loved playing the wash board in the XYZ band.

She is survived by a daughter, Janice Blackstock Kelley and her husband, Wilbur of Evington; two sons, Edwin Keith Blackstock and his wife, Sue of Altavista and Roger Craig Blackstock and his wife, Darlene of Lynch Station; nine grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; a sister, Lula Mae Ogle Shinault and a sister in law, Aline Ogle both of Austinville, VA.

She was preceded in death by one sister and six brothers.
