Martin Clay Gibson, 91, of 665 Stone Mill Road, Hurt died Monday, October 3, 2011 at the V.A. Medical Center of Salem. He was the husband of Lorene Dillard Gibson for seventy-three years. He was born February 10, 1920 in Pittsylvania County, a son of the late Robert Lee Gibson and Nellie Hayden Gibson. He was a member of Hurt Pentecostal Holiness Church while serving as superintendant of Sunday school, a member of the Deacon Board, and Trustee. He was a former employee of Burlington Mills and retired as owner of Gibson Welding Shop. Mr. Gibson was a U.S. Marine Corps veteran and served our country during World War II.
