Grady Marvin Skeen, Jr., 75, of 308 Windsong Drive, Lynch Station died Tuesday, October 29, 2013 at his home. He was the husband of Jean Sykes Skeen for fifty-four years.

He was born April 14, 1938 in Russell County, a son of the late Grady Marvin Skeen, Sr. and Kathleen Davis Moore. He was a member of Mount Hermon United Methodist Church, the Lynch Station Ruritan Club, and a veteran of the Army National Guard. Marvin retired as a processing engineer with BGF Industries and was the owner of Corner House Furniture.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Kimberly Dawn Skeen Towler and her husband Mike of Altavista; two half-sisters, Lyndell Yeatts of Hollywood, MD and Robin Skeen Harris of Roanoke; and a granddaughter, Hannah Gracyn Towler.

He was preceded in death by a half-brother, Fred Moore.

A funeral service will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, November 2, 2013 at Mount Hermon United Methodist Church by the Rev. Bill Greer. Burial will follow in Altavista Memorial Park with military honors by Altavista Memorial American Legion Post 36 and V.F.W. Post 4165.

The family will receive friends from 7-8:30 p.m., Friday at Finch and Finch Funeral and Cremation Service, Altavista and other times at the residence.

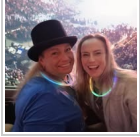
