August 15, 1918 - October 23, 2010

Mary Frances Green Harvey, 92, formerly of Altavista, passed away Saturday, October 23, 2010 in the Emeritus at Wilburn Gardens in Fredericksburg, VA. She was the beloved wife of the late Eugene Bruce Harvey. She was born in Hurt, on August 15, 1918, a daughter of the late James Adam Green and Mabel Addie Winn Green. She was a member of Altavista Presbyterian Church where she was an elder, moderator of Presbyterian Women, and one of the founders of Second Helping. She had an associate degree in bookkeeping from the University of Mary Washington in Fredericksburg. She worked at the Lane Company until 1957 and later retired as bookkeeper with the former Clantons Drug Store in Altavista in 1984. Surviving are a son, Eugene Bruce Harvey, Jr. and his wife Bridget of Fredericksburg; a daughter, Anna Frances Harvey Shelton and her husband Bruce of Hatfield, PA; four grandchildren, Bryan Scott Harvey of Alexandria, Brittany Grace Harvey of Austin, TX, Mary Frances Shelton of Roanoke, VA and Jeffery Bruce Shelton of Hatfield, PA; and two sisters, Marguerite Pender and her husband Joe of Roswell, GA and Mittie Gay and her husband Johnny of Altavista.
