Mary Lois Jennings Kirkpatrick, 93, of Gretna died Saturday, July 8, 2017 at Lynchburg General Hospital. She was the wife of Thomas Luther Kirkpatrick for seventy-one years and she died in the faith of Christ after devoting her life to the raising and care of her family.

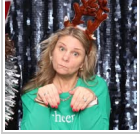
