Nancy Kelly Gregory, 83, formerly of Rustburg, Virginia, died Monday, June 27, 2022, at Bickford Assisted Living in Midlothian, Virginia. She was the wife of the late Roy Wayne Gregory.

She was born January 29, 1939, in Hurt, a daughter of the late Silas Daniel Kelly and Celestia Pearl Dunn Kelly. She was a member of New Bethel United Methodist Church and a retired teacher for Campbell County Public Schools.
