Nancy Lee Scherzer Webster, 78, of Altavista died Monday, October 27, 2014 at her home. She was the wife of Major (USA, Ret.) Rudolph "Rudy" P. Webster for almost sixty-one years.

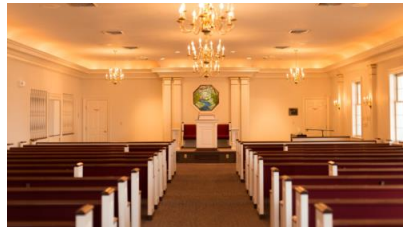

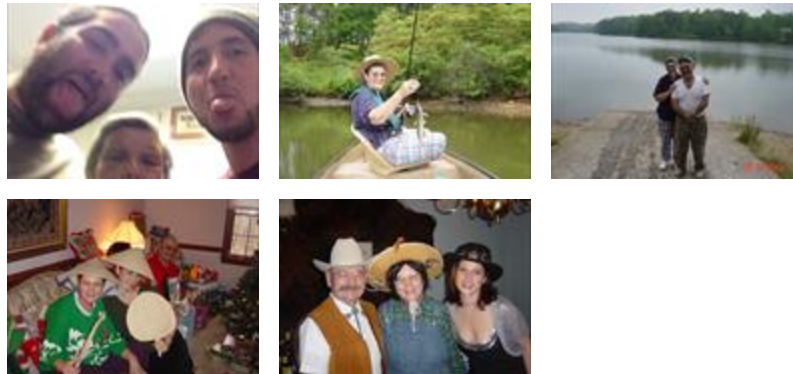

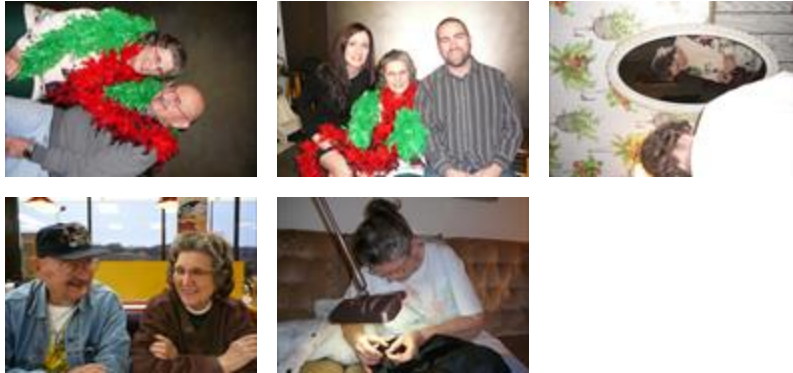
