Oscar Clyde Adkins, 83, of 6454 Wards Road, Rustburg died Thursday, February 21, 2019 at his home. He was the husband of Nancy Bowles Adkins for sixty-four years.

He was born September 14, 1935 in Pittsylvania County, a son of the late Clyde Adkins and Shirley Moses Adkins. He was a member of Yellow Branch Baptist Church and Lynchburg Lodge #715 Loyal Order of the Moose. 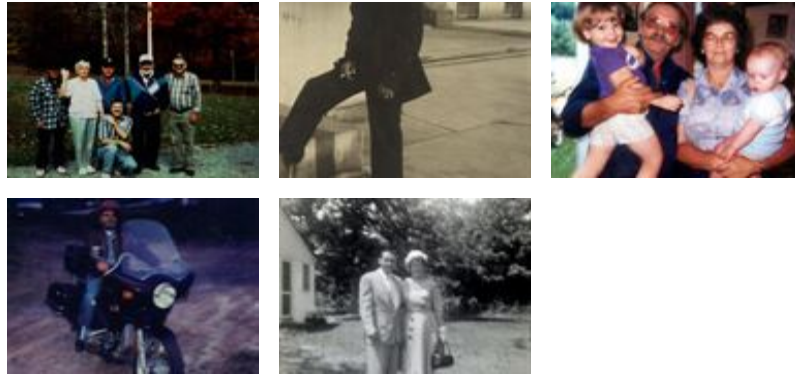
