Patricia Anne Patton, beloved educator and devoted community member, passed away on March 28, 2025, at the age of 88. Born on March 7, 1937, in Altavista, Virginia, Patricia dedicated her life to family, friends, faith, education, and service to her community.

A lifelong member of Central Baptist Church of Altavista, Patricia was deeply involved in her church and community organizations. She dedicated 34 years to shaping young minds as a school teacher with Campbell County Public Schools. Her passion for education extended beyond the classroom, as she was an active member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International IOTA Chapter, an organization dedicated to promoting excellence in education. Additionally, she was a cherished member of the Altavista Garden Club and the Altavista Women's Club, where she cultivated lasting friendships and contributed to her community's enrichment.

Patricia was preceded in death by her loving parents, Miller Adair Patton and Francis Tinnin Patton. She is survived by her cousins, Ann Irvin, Ann Bellany, Ray Ramey, Jr., John Tinnin, and Terri Amory, as well as their children, all of whom will cherish her memory.

with interment to follow in Green Hill Cemetery.
