Randolph Arlington Maddox, Jr., 63, of Evington died August 19, 2021 at Gretna Health and Rehab. He was the husband of Catherine Owens Maddox for twenty years.

He was born November 16, 1957 in Lynchburg, a son of Ruby Joyce Deaton Maddox and the late Randolph Arlington Maddox, Sr. He was a member of Timberlake Christian Church, a retired employee of twenty-seven years from the Lynchburg City School System, and a U.S. Navy veteran. Randy was also a member at the Lynchburg South Moose #1727, Lynchburg South Moose Legion, and the Campbell County Rescue Squad for forty-five years. He was a past member of Brookville-Timberlake, Lyn-Dan Heights, and Evington Volunteer Fire Departments.

In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by his father-in-law, Robert E. Owens.

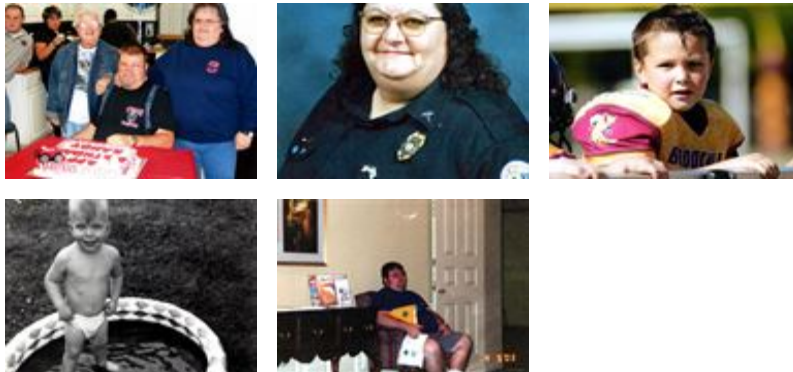
