Roger Buddy Wilson, 86, of Lynch Station, passed away at home on December 3, 2024. He was the husband of Connie Phillips Wilson for 63 years. He was born on December 21, 1937, in Altavista, Virginia. He was the son of the late Ruby Wilson Niswander. He is preceded in death by his stepfather, Bill Niswander and his brother, William Amos Niswander.

In addition to Roger's wife, he is survived by his two sons, Stacy Wilson and his wife Brigitte of Forest, and Will Wilson and his wife Tammy of Altavista; one sister, Susan Eades and her husband Dexter of Lynch Station and their children, Becky and Lauren; his grandson Hunter Wilson, and his step-granddaughter Chanler Hall.

Roger was an avid hunter and fisherman. He enjoyed spending time with family and many friends. Always a joker, filled with smiles and laughter, giving frequent pats on the back. He served 23 years for the Altavista Post Office and served 6 years as Postmaster of the Evington Post Office. Roger retired from the United States Postal Office in 1993. He is a U.S. Army Veteran, an associate member of the Lynch Station Ruritan Club, and Campbell Masonic Lodge # 316. A former volunteer of many Altavista community and school events. He was a member of Lane Memorial United Methodist Church.

A graveside service will be held at 2:00 p.m. Sunday, December 8, 2024 at

Mount Hermon Church Cemetery, Lynch Station by Pastor Yusang Chung with military honors by American Legion Altavista Memorial Post 36 and Gretna Post 232. The family will receive friends following the service and other times at the residence.
