



Rondell Charles McPeters

June 6, 1934 - January 5, 2025

Rondell Charles McPeters, 90, of 223 Penuel Lane, Altavista died Sunday, January 5, 2025 at the home of his son, Jon, surrounded by family. He was the husband of Catherine McDaniel McPeters for 68 years.

He was born June 6, 1934 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia, a son of the late Charles Edwin McPeters and Minnie Gregory McPeters. He was a member of Lambs Community Church, a retired employee of BWXT, and a U.S. Army veteran.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by three sons, Jon McPeters of Altavista, Tim McPeters and his wife, Alicia of Chesterfield, VA and Ron McPeters, Jr. and his wife, Kathy of Greer, SC; one daughter, Jan McKinney of Forest; one brother, Neal McPeters and his wife, Marilyn of Disputanta, VA; eight grandchildren, Lauren Taeger and her husband, Greg, Lisa Steiger and her husband, Andre, Shea McPeters and his wife, Julie, Kevin McPeters, Eric McPeters, Sydney Pugh and her husband, Trevor, Ethan McPeters and T.J. McPeters; and eight great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Edwin McPeters; and one granddaughter, Caroline McPeters.

Dad was a man of strong faith, communicating the message of everlasting life

by belief in Jesus Christ until the very end. His family, especially his grandchildren (who dubbed him "Crumps") were a source of pride and great enjoyment. He was a strong supporter of his church, serving for decades in many roles, including Sunday school teacher and treasurer. Dad never met a stranger, and never went anywhere without striking up random conversations with both adults and children.

A graveside service will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, January 11, 2025 at Lambs Community Church Cemetery by the Rev. Dr. Ricky Ewing with military honors by American Legion Altavista Memorial Post 36 and Gretna Post 232.

The family will receive friends following the service in the fellowship hall at Lambs Community Church.
