Rosa Victoria Tanner Evans Harris passed away peacefully on March 10, 2017. She was born in Gladys on December 31, 1919 to Charles and Lena Whately Tanner.

Vic graduated from Longwood College and taught school in Campbell and near by counties for over 40 years. She taught every grade and in facilities ranging from a one-room school house to today's modern facilities. She married Thomas W. Evans (Jack) in 1946 and they were married for 30 years until his death. In 1989 she married H. Herbert Harris and they were married until his death in 2006. Vic was a long-time member of Diamond Hill Presbyterian Church, a great cook, avid gardener, and competitive swimmer. She competed in several Senior Olympics and swam competitively well into her 80s.
