



## Scott Finch

November 22, 1961 - November 19, 2012

Douglas "Scott" Finch, 50, died November 19, 2012 at his home in Little Rock, Arkansas, after a long, courageous battle with multiple myeloma. Scott was born in Altavista, to Ollie Lee Cundiff, who preceded him in death, and E. Wayne Finch. He graduated from Altavista High School, then attended Chowan and Elon Colleges in North Carolina, where he earned a business degree and played football. He was a lifelong fan of that sport and many others, and played all with a winning attitude.

Scott worked in the furniture industry as a salesman for many years, first with The Lane Company, then with Lexington Furniture, then with Norwalk Furniture, among others. Most recently, Scott worked for Batesville Casket Company. He brought the same work ethic and desire to succeed to his career as he had to sports, and received many accolades in both arenas.

Scott is survived by his wife Diane (Compeau), whom he married in 1994. In Virginia, he is survived by his father, E. Wayne Finch and stepmother, Ruby Finch, of Altavista, his brother, Stan Finch and sister-in-law, Sandra Finch of Altavista, stepsisters Pam Jones and Teresa Rice of Lynchburg, and nephews Michael Finch and Nicholas Jones, as well as many other family and friends.

A memorial service will be held at 4:00 p.m., Friday, December 7, 2012 at the Finch & Finch Chapel, Altavista by the Dr. Rev. Michael Lee.

Family will receive friends at the funeral home prior to the service beginning at 2:30 p.m.
