



Ted Maxton Hogan, Sr.

Ted Maxton Hogan, 88, of 114 Hogan Hill Lane, Lynch Station died Sunday, February 26, 2017 at Autumn Care of Altavista. He was the husband of Dorothy Taylor "Dot" Hogan for nearly 65 years.

He was born October 2, 1928 in Lynch Station, a son of the late John Roy Hogan, Sr. and Merlo Johnson Hogan. He was a member of Mount Hermon United Methodist Church, a retired employee of Klopman Mills, a Cub Scout Master and a U.S. Army Veteran.

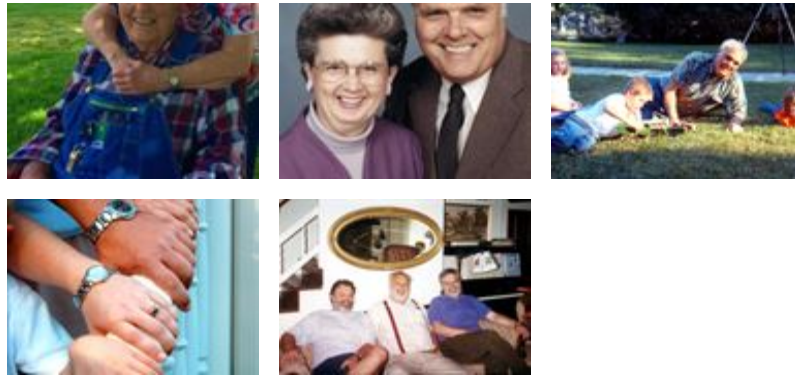
