



Vera Lee Eggers Tucker

November 13, 1924 - June 2, 2013

Vera Lee Eggers Tucker, 88, of Lynch Station, died Sunday, June 2, 2013 at Heritage Green Assisted Living in Lynchburg. She was the wife of the late Fred Kabler Tucker, Sr.

She was born November 13, 1924 in Lynchburg, a daughter of the late Charles F. Eggers and Bonnie Perry Eggers. She was a member of Lynch Station Baptist Church and a retired employee of Burlington Industries. Vera and her husband were best known as the "Tag Lady and Tag Man" for collecting antique license plates.

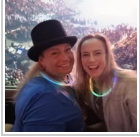
