Victoria Anne White Elliott, 69, of 122 Ridgeview Road, Hurt died Sunday, February 21, 2021 at Centra Lynchburg General Hospital. She was the wife of Albert J. Elliott, Sr. for fifty-two years.

She was born February 26, 1951 in Charlottesville, a daughter of the late Thomas Jefferson White and Margaret Showalter White. She was a member of Bethel Pentecostal Holiness Church, Gladys and a retired school bus driver for Campbell County. Vicki loved gospel singings, cooking and was a caretaker to all.
