Violet Pat B. Rolfe Mayhew, 94, died Friday, January 14, 2011 at Virginia Baptist Hospital after a short illness. Born February 18, 1916 in Point Pleasant, W.VA to Lee and Rebecca Burgess, she was the youngest of seven children.
