



William Monroe Moore Sr.

March 25, 1930 - April 3, 2023

William "Bill" Monroe Moore, Sr., 93, recently of Alexandria, VA, passed away on Monday, April 3, 2023 in Gainesville, Virginia. Bill was the eldest son of the late John William Moore and Grace Mae Gross Moore.

Bill served in the United States Army for nearly 30 years, retiring as a Command Sgt. Major. He was a Korean War veteran and later served on the Presidential Flight Detachment (Helicopter Support) for presidents Johnson, Nixon, and Ford. Following retirement from the military, Mr. Moore worked for the U.S. Secret Service in Washington, D.C.

Bill enjoyed driving and tinkering with his 1963 ½ Ford Galaxie 500 and showing it off at car shows. He was a faithful fan of the Baltimore Orioles, and of the Baltimore Ravens -- he proudly displayed purple flamingos in his front yard on occasion to show Ravens support. He loved sun-bathing and enjoyed years at his time-share in the Bahamas and his and Polly's condo in Ocean City, MD. He will be missed by family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of 71 years, Pauline A. Moore; his daughter, Gail Philippi (Frank); a son, William M. Moore, Jr. (Lois); three grandsons, a brother, Frank; three sisters, Ann, Patricia, and Helen; and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by three brothers, Dallas, John and Aubrey; and four sisters, Jane, Merelyn, Kathleen, and infant, Brenda Sue.

A funeral service will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Friday, April 7, 2023 at Motley United Methodist Church by the Rev. Steve Morris with interment to follow in the church cemetery with military honors by American Legion Altavista Memorial Post 36 and Gretna Post 232.

The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service at the church.

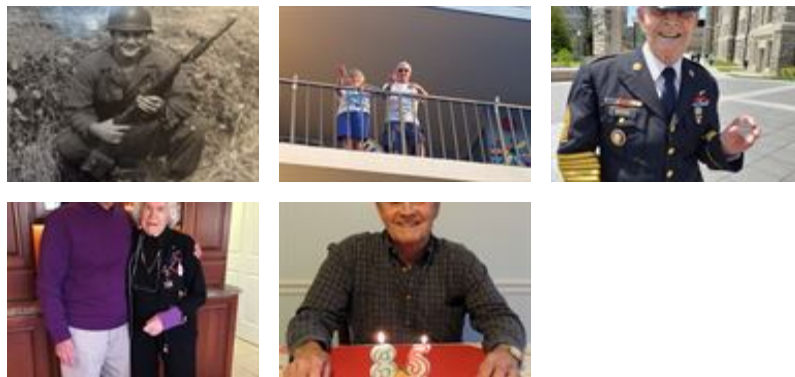
