William Clifton Phillips, 93, of Altavista died Friday, October 19, 2018 at his home. He was the husband of the late Kathryn Mayo Phillips.

Cliff was born August 3, 1925 in Evington, a son of the late Paul Whitehead Phillips and Helen Arthur Phillips. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II.
